BIBLE PASSAGE

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.

Galatians 5:22-23

FOR THE VIDEO

- Gather your family. Open your favorite Bible or Bible app. Have each person share one thing that makes your family special.
- Pause the video as needed! Ask questions. Share stories.

AFTER THE VIDEO

Talk about these questions with your family:

1. How did the little girl show Naaman goodness?
2. Why would the little girl want to help Naaman after he had hurt her family?
3. What was the difference between the little girl's heart and Naaman's heart?
4. How do you feel when you do the right thing? How do you feel when you do the wrong thing?

ACTIVITIES FOR THIS WEEK:

- **Goodness Game:** Grab a dice, choose a game piece, and print this [board game](#) to play with your family.
- **Garden of Goodness:** On a piece of paper, draw 1-3 large flowerpots. On each flowerpot, draw a picture that shows goodness in action. Draw flowers inside the flowerpot to see your garden of goodness grow.
- **Catch the Fruit of the Spirit:** Find a ball and have your family stand in a circle. Play a game of catch that helps you remember the Fruit of the Spirit. Start the game by saying "Love" and passing the ball to the next person. Instruct them to say "Joy" and toss the ball to the next person. Keep playing until your family knows them all!
- **Fruit of the Spirit Mobile:** Continue making your Fruit of the Spirit mobile by printing this [GOODNESS image](#). Cut out the image and hang it from your mobile with string.
- **56 Students—Digging deeper:** Make a goodness collage. Cut out images or words from the newspaper or magazines or print images from your computer of people doing the right thing. Glue them on a paper to make a collage. Read these verses from the Bible to learn more about goodness. (*Psalms 31:19; Galatians 6:9; 1 Thess. 5:15*)
