BIBLE PASSAGE

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.

Galatians 5:22-23

FOR THE VIDEO

- Gather your family. Open your favorite Bible or Bible app. Have each person share something they love about God.
- Pause the video as needed! Ask questions. Share stories.

AFTER THE VIDEO

Talk about these questions with your family:

1. What did Daniel do every day, three times a day?
2. Why was Daniel thrown into the lions' den?
3. How was Daniel faithful to God in this story? How was God faithful to Daniel?
4. How can you show faithfulness to God this week?

ACTIVITIES FOR THIS WEEK:

- **Popsicle Stick Promises:** Write one true promise from God on a popsicle stick using this [list of promises](#). Make a total of 10 popsicle sticks with 10 different promises written on them. Hide the sticks around your house and invite your family to find them. As they are found, read aloud the promise and think about the faithfulness of God!
- **Fruit of the Spirit Trail Mix:** Follow [this recipe](#) to make a fun summertime snack for the whole family.
- **Faithfulness Ribbons:** Gather a handful of sticks and some short pieces of ribbon or yarn (6" lengths). Work together to tie the ribbons around the sticks. While you tie the ribbons, talk about how faithfulness is like wrapping our arms around God, knowing He will take care of us. Place the sticks and tied ribbons in a jar to remind you that you can place your faith in God each day!
- **Fruit of the Spirit Mobile:** Continue making your Fruit of the Spirit mobile today by printing this [FAITHFULNESS image](#), if you haven't already done so. Cut out the image and then hang it from your mobile with string. We'll add another Fruit of the Spirit image next week.
- **56 Students-Digging deeper:** Write Isaiah 25:1 (NIV) onto a piece of paper. God's faithfulness is perfect! On the other side of the paper, make a list of "wonderful things" you know God has done. Hang your list in a place where you will see it each day.
