Reflect + Discuss

- Do you ever daydream about the future, either for yourself or on a more global scale? If so, what type of things do you imagine when you think of an ideal future?
- Read Micah 4:1-5. What stands out to you? What questions do you have? What aspects of Micah's vision for the future are most appealing to you?
- Our world seems deeply enamored with the first of part of Micah's vision but ignores verses 4b - 5. Why is crucial to look at Micah's vision wholistically?
- In what ways does God's peace differ from the kind of peace humans are typically capable of?
- God wants to use His people to show the world that peace is possible, and for us to be a community with no ethnic hostility. How are we as the people of God doing in this regard? What is a next step that you can take to be someone who extends love across racial barriers, ethnic barriers, and language barriers?

- Pray that we, as God's people, would be people who put ethnic hostility to death, and love others well. Pray for wisdom and soft hearts to be learners in this process, and that we would seek God's peace in our community.
