Role Description: Community Group leaders are responsible for fostering healthy, Christ-centered community for their groups; it is an important, crucial role! As the leader, you will guide your group through weekly Sunday message discussions (or other content), help your group grow in their relationship with God and with each other, and work to instill a heart of service within your group. We want groups to be a place where people engage and grow, and we want leaders to build up their group members and help them lean into their giftings – this can be done through sharing certain leadership responsibilities, affirming their gifts, empowering them to share their story, encouraging them to branch out and lead a new group, etc.

Qualifications:

- Exhibits a personal, growing relationship with Jesus Christ
- Recognizes the Bible as the authority for their lives
- Previous group experience
- Possesses the time, emotional capacity, relational warmth, and moral discernment to lead a group

Responsibilities:

- Complete Basic Training before starting a group
- Engage in leadership development opportunities provided by the church (typically twice per ministry year)
- Lead the group by facilitating the weekly meetings, monitoring its health and encouraging participation amongst group members
- Commit to staying connected with a Community Group coach for support, trouble shooting and encouragement
