

## Fall Family Camp FAQ

**Purpose:** Fall Family Camp is a time for you to connect as a family and with others while enjoying all that Fort Wilderness has to offer.

**Who:** This weekend is designed for families who have middle & high school-age students. If you also have younger kids, they are welcome too! Parents/guardians, you will be responsible for your kid(s) throughout the weekend since we will not be providing adult leaders for this trip. At least one parent/guardian needs to attend for your kid(s) to participate.

**Location:** [Fort Wilderness, Rhinelander, WI.](#)

**Transportation:** You will be responsible for your own transportation as a family to and from camp.

**Lodging:** Each family will have their own accommodation. There are three lodging options for families to choose from (if one-fills, we will make that clear on the registration form).

1. **Inn Room** (\$145 per person):
  - a. Family shares a room; most have a queen bed + a bunk + day bed
  - b. Hotel like accommodations; linens provided
  - c. Attached private bathroom with shower
2. **Cabins** with private bathroom (\$125 per person):
  - a. Family shares a cabin; most have 5-6 bunk beds w/one full bed on a bottom of one bunk
  - b. Linens not provided
  - c. Attached private bathroom with shower
3. **RV or Pop-up/Tent Campsites** (\$80 per person):
  - a. Short walk to central bathroom facility
  - b. Fire ring and electricity at each site
  - c. RV sites include septic, and water, and can accommodate large RVs
  - d. RVs and Pop-ups can be rented locally from [Shoeder's RV & Marine](#)

**Meals:** Meals will be prepared by Fort Wilderness staff.

## Outdoor Activity Options:

*\*Please note that activities are dependent on Fort Wilderness staff availability. A finalized list of all available activities for FFC will be sent to registered families prior to camp weekend.*

- Horseback riding- typically pony rides for anyone under 8 years old, 8 and up can do trail rides
- Nature Center classes
- Boats/swimming
- Fishing (bring your own equipment)
- Nature Hikes
- Archery (3D available if you provide your own bow) 12 and under should be accompanied by an adult.
- .22 Range - 12 and under should be accompanied by an adult.
- Shotgun Range - 12 and under should be accompanied by an adult.
- Canteen/Coffee Shop - Bring extra money; cash and card accepted
- Carpetball/Horseshoes/Gaga ball
- Climbing Tower - 7 and under need to have an adult present and must fit the harnesses at Fort Wilderness.

**Registration:** Will open **Wednesday, August 31<sup>st</sup>** and will close on **September 19<sup>th</sup>**

**Cost:** The cost covers lodging, meals, and activities. There are three cost options based on what lodging you choose. See lodging section above for more info.

**Cancellation/Reimbursement Policy:** If a cancellation occurs after the registration deadline due to something COVID- related, other sickness, or a family emergency, a full refund will be provided.
