### Reflect + Discuss

- What is your neighborhood like? Who are your neighbors?
- Have you ever been blessed or helped by a total stranger?
- Read Luke 10:25-37. What stands out? What questions do you have? Is there anything new that's sticking out to you about this familiar passage?
- How would Jesus define a neighbor? Who are the unlikely "neighbors" God might want to make us aware of today?
- Are there situations you find yourself in that feel challenging or uncomfortable to choose to love your neighbor? What's one thing that might help you overcome that?
- What are the Jericho roads you walk down regularly? Are there places where you notice a great need?
- Think about your neighbors—the ones you notice and the ones that are hard to notice, those that feel like neighbors and those that feel like enemies. What could loving them look like this week?

### Pray

- Consider your neighbors and pray for them—for their health, their flourishing, and any other things that come to mind. Ask God to help you be a neighbor that shows the love of Christ and is willing to cross boundaries or take on the cost to love and care for others. Pray that he would move you to put that love into action in a way that reflects the values of the kingdom.
