Reflect + Discuss

- Can you think of a favorite gift you have received in your life or a favorite gift you have given to someone? What made that gift so special?
- Read Philippians 4:10-13. Why is it significant that Paul says, 'I am not saying this because I am in need'? How is biblical generosity different from fundraising?
- Read Philippians 4:17-23. Why does Paul rejoice to see the Philippians live generously? Why do you think Paul never mentions the amount that was given? How is having a generous heart an indicator of spiritual transformation?
- Read Acts 20:35. In what ways have you experienced this verse to be true in your life? Have you ever experienced pure joy through giving? What are some practical ways we can embrace the theology of generosity and live more generous lives in this season (i.e. Advent Conspiracy)?
- As you look back on our journey through the Philippians series, what have been some key takeaways for you? How has this series impacted your relationship with God and others?

- Pray that God will help us to live out Paul's prayer for the Philippians. Pray that we may seek the transformation that comes through following Paul's example and by living generously. Pray for God to lead us towards progress and joy in our faith.
