Responsibilities

Sunday Staffing

Act as a primary leader for one Sunday service hour in Blackhawk Kids.

Ensure a safe and engaging spiritual environment for children and volunteers.

- Track volunteer assignments to ensure appropriate volunteer-to-child ratios in each room, closing rooms as needed.
- Communicate weekly with ministry or site coordinator.
- Connect with parents on Sundays; be the "familiar face" for the service hour.
- Fill in as large group Room Host when needed.

Volunteer Care and Connection

- Provide encouragement, support, and coaching for volunteers on Sundays and during the week.
- Assist in scheduling volunteers for the assigned service hour.
- Assist in identifying, meeting with, and placing new volunteers and leaders into the ministry.
- Meet with Room Leaders and Room Hosts for care and coaching.
- Collaborate as a member of the Blackhawk Kids Team to plan volunteer training, volunteer appreciation, and events that build volunteer community.

> Team Participation

- Participate in ministry evaluation, goal setting, and direction.
- Participate in the planning and implementation of volunteer training events.
- Attend monthly ministry or site staff team meetings.
- Meet biannually for coaching with the ministry or site coordinator.
