## Responsibilities

#### Special Needs Ministry

- Recruit and oversee the on-ramp of an Includer volunteer team.
  - Coach and support Includers, offering additional training, resources, or brainstorming related to the children they serve. Be present onsite the mornings a new Includer is training (approximate timeframe: from 8:15 am huddle through the volunteer's service hour).
  - Develop ideas for training Includers and other volunteer roles that intersect.
- Connect with parents, children, and volunteers to develop a plan for each child with special needs who desires to be part of BKids.
  - Manage Includer scheduling.
  - Equip Includers to communicate with families.
  - Be an onsite presence to oversee the implementation of the plans put in place.
- Champion Special Needs, ensuring a well-equipped ministry that is a cohesive part of BKids.
  - Research and identify best practices for caring for kids with special needs on Sundays. Connect with other churches to learn about their ministry to kids with special needs.
  - In collaboration with the Associate Director of BKids and site coordinators, envision the future of Special Needs Ministry, and implement incremental, sustainable steps forward.

## Teamwork

- Collaborate as a member of the Blackhawk Kids Team to:
  - Implement events and trainings,
  - Participate in ministry evaluation, goal setting, and direction.
- Meet biannually for coaching with the Associate Director of BKids.
