High School Ministry (HSM)

- Lead central HSM vision, strategy, implementation, budget, and evaluation. Ensure healthy ministry development across all sites.
 - Oversee programming, events, service projects, GO Teams, etc. Be a regular presence and connector at ministry gatherings.
 - Ensure the creation of resources (e.g., tools, systems, training) so staff and volunteers can implement ministry with quality and consistency.
 - Oversee content/curriculum in collaboration with Middle School Ministry (MSM). Teach in applicable settings.
 - Ensure our multicultural value continues to be developed and incorporated into the ministry.
- Lead the HSM Team.
 - Supervise HSM staff and interns.
 - Recruit, train, and develop multigenerational, multicultural volunteer leaders. Foster a culture where volunteers are spiritual shepherds to students.
- Gather high school students into community and connection as part of the local church.
 - Ensure connecting points for students within HSM and the church community.
 - Connect with students and their families on Sundays and other churchwide events.
 - o Provide wise Biblical care in personal life situations of students and families.

- Partner with the MSM Pastor for a cohesive Student Ministry, collaborating on areas of strategic overlap (e.g., content/curriculum, supporting parents, leader training, student serving opportunities).
