Reflect + Discuss

- What's one of your most prized possessions? What makes that item so special to you? What do you do to keep it protected?
- Read Romans 8:31-39. What phrases stick out to you from this passage? Does any line particularly resonate for you? How does this passage tie together all of Romans 8?
- Read Romans 8:31-32. How do the words "God is for you" resonate in your life? Do you believe that God is for you? In what ways do you experience this? In what ways is this hard for you to believe?
- Read Romans 8:33-34. When you think about God, do you tend to imagine him more as the judge or as your defense attorney? Why is it good news that Jesus is our representation?
- Read Romans 8:1. According to Paul, how has our position changed when we place our faith in Christ? In the moments when we feel condemnation, how can this verse help us regain perspective?
- If you feel comfortable sharing, what's one area where you're lacking a feeling of safety, stability, or security? How does our secure position in Christ impact the way you think about that area?
- Read Romans 8:37-39. How do these verses make you feel? How can we be encouraged to know that nothing can ever separate us from the love of God? How does our secure position in Christ free us to join God in his mission to reach and restore the world?

Pray

Pray for us to have a growing understanding of God's great love for us and that we would find security in our position in Christ. Pray that we would be a community that lives out of this new identity as we experience both good times and times of suffering.
