Responsibilities

➤ Sunday Staffing

- Lead a ministry group for one Sunday service in Blackhawk Kids.
- Ensure a safe and engaging spiritual environment for children and volunteers.
- Track volunteer assignments to ensure appropriate volunteer-to-child ratios in each room, closing rooms as needed.
- Connect with parents on Sundays; be the “familiar face” for the service.
- Fill in as large group Room Host when needed.
- Communicate weekly with ministry or site coordinator.

➤ Volunteer Care and Connection

- Provide encouragement, support, and coaching for volunteers on Sundays and during the week.
- Assist in scheduling volunteers for the assigned service.
- Assist in identifying, interviewing, and placing new volunteers and leaders into the ministry.

➤ Teamwork

- Collaborate as a member of the Blackhawk Kids Team to:
 - Implement events and trainings,
 - Participate in ministry evaluation, goal setting, and direction.
- Attend quarterly ministry or site staff team meetings.
- Meet biannually for coaching with the ministry or site coordinator.
