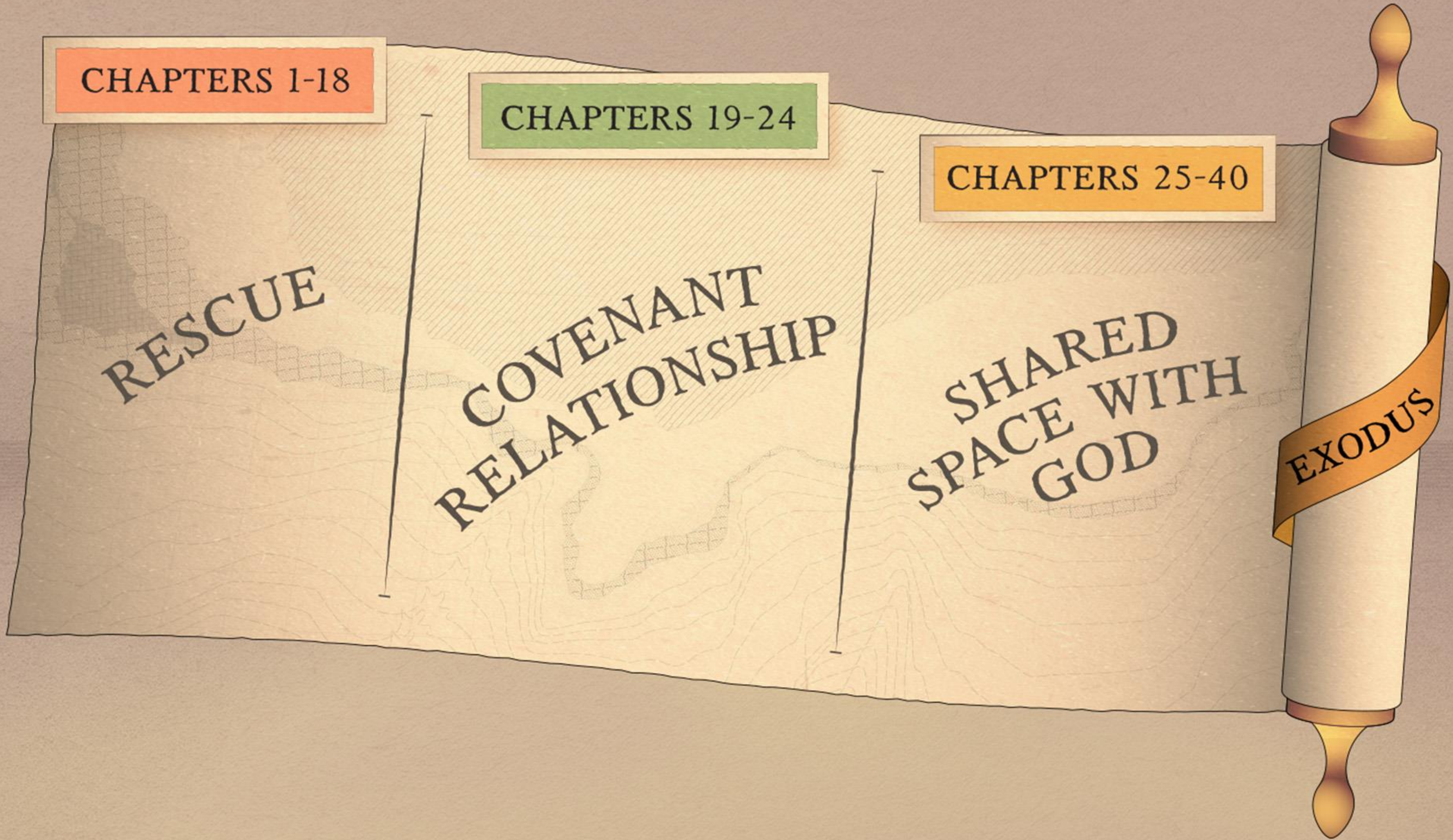



and woo a rebellious world back to him.







Exodus 20:13-16 (NIV)

28 “If a bull gores a man or woman to death, the bull is to be stoned to death, and its meat must not be eaten. 


