Reflect + Discuss

- If you won a million dollars today, how would you spend it?
- What messages about money did you receive growing up? Were there any sayings or beliefs about money that shaped you? (i.e. “Money can’t buy happiness,” “Money is power,” or “Money talks.”)
- Read Luke 12:15. How have your life experiences affirmed or challenged this statement? What has made it difficult or easier for you to believe?
- Matt mentioned three heart issues that make us doubt Jesus’ teaching on money: fear, greed and status. Which one do you resonate with most? What are the “what if’s” that keep you awake at night? What do you find yourself wishing you had more of?
- How can God meet the needs that we look to money to fulfill? In what ways have you experienced God to be your security, satisfaction or source of identity? If there’s an area of growth for you, what do you think it would look like to trust God more deeply in those ways?
- Matt shared how a plant can only grow as large as the pot it's planted and he compared the pot to our trust in God. What might it look like for you to move to a bigger pot with trusting God right now? How can we practically grow in trusting God (i.e. hearing others' stories, taking small steps of obedience, something else)?
- Read Matthew 6:21. Where is your heart currently at? Where do you want your heart to be? What’s one practical step you could take this week toward greater simplicity for yourself and greater generosity toward others?
- How can this community group support one another as we move from “I Doubt It” to “I Trust It” when it comes to Jesus’ teaching about money? For example, how might confession, prayer, encouragement, and accountability help free us from being controlled by money and keep us centered on God?

Pray

Pray that we may grow in understanding how deeply God desires to meet our needs and how faithfully He provides for us. Pray that we may grow in the practice of generosity so that we can experience true security, satisfaction and identity that are found in Him alone. As we continue to reflect on this message, pray that God would give us the courage to take our next step of faith and embark on a journey of unhindered growth.
